**Qualifications:** For postdoctoral (PDF) positions, a Ph.D. in Biological or Chemical Sciences with requisite experience and interest is required. For Research Assistant (RA) positions, a B.Sc. in Biology/Chemistry/Physics with requisite experience and interest is required.

**PDF 1:** To work on the molecular biology of hepatitis E virus. Competence in basic molecular biology with experience in either confocal microscopy, analysis of protein–protein interactions, or signal transduction.

**PDF 2:** To work on the immunology of hepatitis E virus. Competence in basic molecular biology and immunology with experience in FACS analysis of T cell populations or high resolution HLA typing.

**PDF 3:** To work on molecular cloning of plasmodial genes. Experience in basic molecular biology techniques including Southern, Westerns and EIAs.

**PDF 4:** To work on 3D structure determination of parasite proteins. Experience in X-ray crystallography of proteins or small molecules.

**RA 1:** To work on the production of recombinant hepatitis E viral proteins. Experience in insect or animal cell culture is essential. Working knowledge of the baculovirus expression system will be an advantage.

**RA 2:** To manage the confocal microscope facility. Experience with microscopy and instrumentation will be an advantage.

**RA 3:** To manage the Biacore facility. Experience with microscopy and instrumentation will be an advantage.
